

Your rights

Right of subject access

You have the right to be told by Falmouth & Exeter Students' Union (The SU) whether it or someone else on its behalf is processing your personal data and if so, to be given a description of the personal data, the purposes for which they are being processed and the likely recipients and sources of that personal data. You are also entitled to receive a copy of this personal data.

Right to prevent processing likely to cause damage or distress

You are entitled to request, in writing, that the University does not process personal data where such processing is likely to cause substantial damage or substantial distress to you or another person. There are a number of provisos to this right, in particular:

- The damage or distress must be 'unwarranted'; or
- The processing is not necessary for fulfilling a contract with you; or
- The processing is not necessary for fulfilling a legal obligation of the University; or
- The processing is not necessary for protecting your vital interests
