	<p>Samaritans – negotiating an on campus phone bank for Penryn campus. Will set up a student led volunteer project to volunteer. Will be based near chaplaincy</p> <p>Bystander training working with CRESA They will train 20 dedicated students as train the trainers. Leadership Team</p> <p>Tell Me – 3<sup>rd</sup> party hate crime reporting centre – email goes to President Community &amp; welfare then is signposted on. Want to formalise Tell Me along the lines of See it Say it Sorted. Will be linked with bystander training. Concern about hate crime on campus i&amp; n the community</p> <p>Sexual health clinic – we are piloting a sexual health clinic once a week on campus. Will include STI testing emergency contraception, pregnancy tests and sexual health support. Negotiating with Penryn surgery at the moment.</p> <p>VOICES – about to launch the community edition. 31<sup>st</sup> 7pm in Falmouth Watersports centre. Voices festival on 25<sup>th</sup> May. Producing a VOICES documentary to be premiered. Event will be in Sports Centre, inviting external student unions and universities to attend.</p> <p>Currently no budget for the whole WELFARE portfolio, have a President’s budget so plan to have a budget for successor by the end of the year.</p> <p>Trans 101 is already out of date, will be turned into a video Gender neutral toilets – Gender signs in Stannary being taken down and changed to toilet. Hope to put up a map outlining gender neutral toilets and disabled toilets. MYFALMOUTH system is being remapped and will be able to accommodate preferred names.</p>
